UCSB changes in major preparation for 2017-18 and 2018-19 articulation agreements

The latest articulation agreements published on the ASSIST website are for 2016-17. The following is a list of changes to lower-division major requirements at UCSB in 2017-18 and 2018-19.

Since some courses at community colleges and UCSB have changed, there are new, terminated, and changed articulations that are not on the 2016-17 articulation agreements. Notes have been added to 2016-17 for some of them, particularly those that are required for admission. We are working on making 2017-18 articulation agreements available on our website so that people will be able to see the changed course articulations for 2016-17.

UCSB's selective majors in the College of Engineering and the College of Letters and Science all have the **admission selection criteria** listed on the 2016-17 major articulation agreements. If there were changes to the admission selection criteria, those are explained in notes, so you can find admission selection criteria for fall 2019 on the 2016-17 articulation agreements.
