## CALIFORNIA GENERAL EDUCATION TRANSFER CURRICULUM (Cal-GETC) Merritt College 2025 - 2026

## CAUTION: Cal-GETC may not be the best option for transfer, particularly for majors such as Engineering, Computer Science, Biology, and Business. *See a counselor for more information.*

Completion of Cal-GETC satisfies admission and lower division general education requirements at all CSU campuses and most UC campuses (with some exceptions for colleges and majors), and at many independent and private colleges and universities. However, it is not the only way to fulfill these requirements.

Associate Degrees for Transfer (ADT) to CSU: Completion of the Cal-GETC GE pattern also fulfills the lower division GE requirements for ADTs. Students who started at Merritt (or any California Community College) Fall 2021 or later, and who plan to transfer to a CSU, must complete GE Area 6, Ethnic Studies before or after transfer in order to graduate. Students who started at Merritt (or any California Community College) before Fall 2021 and who have maintained continuous enrollment may not be required to complete this requirement. *See a counselor for more information.* 

**CERTIFICATION:** Merritt College can provide only full certification (completion of requirements in every area); there is currently no partial certification (completion of requirements in one or more areas). All courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or better. Students should request certification when asking that their transcript be sent to the UC or CSU campus of their choice during the final term before transfer. *See a counselor for more information.*
