ADJUSTMENTS FOR TRANSFER STUDENTS FOR 2003-2004 AND 2004-2005 CATALOG YEARS

Beginning with the 2003-2004 catalog, there are some rather large changes in the liberal studies major leading to certification of subject matter competency for admission into a multiple subject teaching credential (elementary school).

All students matriculating at SDSU (except Transfer Studies Degree admits) beginning with Fall 2003 will automatically be required to meet the <u>new</u> degree requirements as listed in the 2003-2004 and later catalogs, and as replicated on the liberal studies checklists.

To ease the transition for junior-level transfer students, the program has filed "blanket waivers" to allow students to satisfy specific requirements in the lower division preparation for the major that are allowed under the 2002-03 catalog. These blanket waivers will be in effect for students matriculating at SDSU in 2003-2004 and 2004-2005 only. (Students taking advantage of these waivers must note that to use the waivers, they must complete their degree by August 2008.)

These waivers will apply only to courses students have taken BEFORE transferring to SDSU. Any course taken after the student matriculates at SDSU must be part of the approved 2003 or later curriculum.

The blanket waiver exceptions are listed below (organized by requirement number, as found in the catalog and the checklist). Any part of the degree NOT listed below must be met as indicated in the 2003-2004 catalog.

HIST-1. New Requirement is Geography 106; waiver will accept Anthropology 102, Geography 102, or Sociology 101.

*HIST-2. New Requirement is Africana Studies 170A, Chicana/Chicano Studies 141A, or History 109; waiver will accept any American Institutions course that is certified, articulated, or equivalent.

*HIST-3. New Requirement is Africana Studies 170B, Chicana/Chicano Studies 141B, History 110, or Political Science 102; waiver will accept any American Institutions course that is certified, articulated, or equivalent.

*The two courses used to satisfy the Hist-2 and Hist-3 requirements must together satisfy the requirement for American Institutions at the college where they were taken or at SDSU.

HIST-4. New Requirement is History 100; waiver will accept History 100, 101, 105, or 106.

SCI-1. New Requirement is Geology 104 or Natural Science 100; waiver will accept *Physical sci*ence--Chemistry 100; Chemistry 200; Physics 107, 180A, 180B, 195, 196, or 197; Natural Science 100; *Earth science*--Astronomy 101, Geography 101, Geography 103, or Geology 100.

SCI-2. New requirement is Biology 203(includes lab); waiver will accept Biology 100 and Biology 100L, Biology 101 and 101L, Biology 201A, or Biology 201B.

VPA-1. New requirement is Art 157 or Theatre 120; waiver will accept Art 157, Art 158, Art 258, Art 259, Theatre 100, or Theatre 120.

TR-1. New requirement is Philosophy 101 or Religious Studies 101; waiver will accept Philosophy 101, 102, or 103 or Religious Studies 101.

Note: For DHP-2. HHS 296 (Health Education for Teachers). If a student has a transferred health education course, he/she should ask at Teacher Education (EDUCATION BUILDING, ROOM 100) to see if the transferred course will be an acceptable substitute for HHS 296.
