**Accreditation Follow-up Workshop Assessment**

The AFR Workshop presentations and activities sought to increase understanding of Merritt College’s Accreditation Status, Accreditation tasks from Fall 2015 through Fall 2016, and four critical institutional processes identified in the 2015 Self-Study Follow-Up Report. There were seven related outcomes identified for the workshop, measured using a pre and post-survey administered to workshop participants.

The pre-survey contained 9 Likert scale questions only, linked to the workshop outcomes. Although the surveys were anonymous, respondents were also asked to identify themselves as Student, Faculty, Classified/Hourly Staff or Administration. Many did not complete the identification question (leaving it blank). 35 pre-surveys were returned, although some were incomplete, leaving questions blank. The post-survey contained the same classification question, 9 Likert scale questions, and included accompanying open-ended questions. 29 post-surveys were returned, however many were incomplete, with several questions blank.

In general, understanding of Merritt College’s Accreditation status and four critical institutional processes seemed to increase. In some cases, like knowledge of the significance of ‘reaffirmation’ vs. ‘show cause,’ and the importance of SLO/SAO assessment, base level understanding was high initially, so the workshop assessment did not indicate a great increase in understanding. In other cases, like the integrated planning and budgeting processes and the purpose of the educational master plan, there seemed to be a significant increase in understanding after workshop activities.

The intent of the workshop was to have participants visit each breakout session and discuss all four institutional processes. The time constraints prohibited participants from discussing more than two of the institutional processes in depth, and likely influenced the lack of complete and thorough responses on the post-survey. In addition, the survey results are aggregated and not paired, so we can only generalize about the change in understanding of the participants as a group and cannot make conclusions about individual change in understanding from pre to post workshop.

A summary of the Likert scale survey questions is below. ‘Strongly Agree’ and ‘Agree’ responses are combined since they would indicate a satisfactory level of understanding.

## AFR Flex-Day and Workshop Observations from Surveys:

### Survey Suggests:

- ☺ We are more clear about the Accreditation Follow-up Report status and timeline!
- ☺ We are more clear about the IPB model and the Educational Master Plan.
- ☺ We are more clear about the importance of SLO assessment.
- ☺ (From second workshop) We are reasonably confident in our ability to articulate the critical institutional processes (especially if handouts are available as a reference).

### Areas of concern:

- The workshops may have only reached approximately 39 individuals. (only 4 respondents noted definitely they **did not** attend the flex day workshop) The majority of people at the second workshop were returning. Several did not confirm that they were at Flex Day or not.
- Even though we understand the importance of SLO assessment, we can improve on using assessment to make improvements and/or improve inter-departmental communication of the use of assessment. Also, the timelines for completing assessment (SLO, PLO or ILO) may be unclear.
  - \*affirmed in the open ended questions – Q3 ex: individuals seek support and training (help), dialogue and greater participation from Faculty and Staff in regards to assessment.
- We can improve on using data in our departments for planning and decision making.
- Significance of reaffirmation vs. show cause (Q9)
  - In both workshops, understanding decreased from Pre survey to Post survey – did people have one idea, and then after the workshop become less clear?
