## Alternate Media Agreement

- 1. Meet with a Disability Services Counselor and get approval for Alternate Media based on disability documentation.
- 2. Register for your classes during Priority Registration.
- 3. Call the Alternate Media Specialist 510-436-2429 or go to R-109 to make an appointment ASAP. Bring your full class schedule and Accommodation Form to set up your Kurzweil, audio books, large print, Braille, or other alternate format.
- 4. You must own a copy of the textbook in order to be allowed to pick up the Kurzweil or audio version. Otherwise, this is violation of Copyright Law. It is also against Copyright Law to give this audio book or electronic text to anyone else.
- 5. If the Alternate Media Specialist cannot locate your book in an alternate format in a timely manner, you may need to have the binding chopped (\$1.49 at Kinkos), so it can be scanned. It can also be rebound (spiral by Kinkos for \$5.00). It will not be able to be sold back to the bookstore. You may also scan your own book (page by page) in the Computer Access Center P-306.
- If you do not have a computer or laptop you can access your books on Kurzweil with headphones in the Computer Access Center (P-306 Monday, Tuesday, Thursday) or in the Learning Center Computer Lab D-178 (Monday - Friday 8 AM to 7 PM).
