Landscape Sketching in the Field

4 weeks, 8 sessions June 4 – 28, 2019 \$230 fee

DESCRIPTION: each day we'll meet at a nearby Bay Area location to sketch the landscape. Our objectives will vary from class to class: line and tone, shade and shadow, color, quick layout strategies, gesture, drawing plants and landscape materials, and more. We'll do a sketch or two each morning and review our work at lunch, and do another sketch and review in the afternoon. By the end of the course you will have done around 16-20 landscape sketches, experimented with a variety of drawing techniques and approaches, had the opportunity to learn from your classmate's work, and visited some interesting local places that are fun to draw. All levels are welcome.
