



Which of the following reflects the Library's reserve borrowing policy?







What tool can you use to find out if the Library has a particular book?




What types of articles are available in the library research databases?







Which of the following is a common citation format for research papers?





What is an example of a periodical?





What tool can you use to find out if the library has a particular magazine?




