## Update: Check Assessment Calendar to Keep on Track and Transition to CurricuNET

Did you know that we now have an Assessment Calendar?

It can be found on the SLOAC website: (http://www.merritt.edu/wp/slo/) on the bottom of the right hand side. This is an excellent guide to keep us on track for when we should be completing each step of the assessment process. By now, all faculty should have identified which SLO(s) they will be assessing as well as the plan for how they will be assessed, and communicated this to their department chair.

Big changes are coming to our assessment platform. We will be transitioning from Taskstream, to

CurricuNET Meta. This system should be live shortly, and SLOAC is looking for departments that would like to be early adopters. I'm happy to move my department as I'm excited about the changes and

the ease of the program. We will be providing training to any faculty that want to transition this semester, and plan to transition all programs in the Spring.
