Program and Committee Updates

Curriculum:

- A lot of new updates to programs. When the new catalog is published please take a minute to review program requirements to see the changes.
- COMM 4 and 20 are for letter grade only to match the other colleges starting in Fall 2025. COMM 4 is changing to Small Group Communication. Still waiting to hear if they will be approved for Cal-GETC. Have to hear back by May 30 for appeals.

Academic Senate:

• 2 FT Nursing Faculty resigned/retired. 2 existing positions posted and might have to replace the new 2 that resigned. Program Director is one of the resignations. BRN says we need to have 8 hires for the program. Need to be at a minimum of 4 to keep the program running. Nursing program could take up to 40 students, but because of staffing ability, can only take 24-30 students. VPI said Nursing is one of the most popular majors for students, losing this program would be fatal for the college. VPI and President looking at hiring immediately.

CFT:

 Discussed Academic Advisement Training, felt confusing. Not every student will have the graduation option on Campus Solutions.

Graduation Committee:

 Reviewed the roles of everyone. Students pick up graduation tickets through student activities. African American Graduation- great time, students had a great day. Dr. Richardson sang the anthem. AAPI graduation was low attended for students per the Dean, but shared it was also a great experience for students.
