Dual enrollment can benefit many high school students, including those from populations facing significant barriers to college success. In this session, presenters will share building a successful dual enrollment course using an online hybrid format, which provided course flexibility, student/faculty engagement, skills development, and onsite student support. Research from the Community College Research Center

presented in Broadening the Benefits of Dual Enrollment (Hughes, 2012) suggests that success is improved when the college has good relationships and communication channels with high school administration, has identified appropriate courses and well-prepared faculty, and has created clear procedures, protocols, and expectations. Presenters will report on student outcomes and lessons learned from the past 3 semesters.
