At the Nov. 2, 2016 meeting, CEMPC finalized its 16-17 goals:

CEMPC Goals...

- 1. Participate in the planning and implementation of Bi-Annual Summits in conjunction with other Participatory Governance Committees to include such topics as Institutional Set Standards, reporting of goals and activities associated with College planning efforts (especially the Educational Master Plan), and other integrated planning and budget efforts.
- 2. Increase and improve effective communication to the Campus community through such activities as, clarifying CEMPC timeline of activities according to the IPB model timeline, posting planning updates on the website, and announcing in monthly newsletters.
- 3. Review APU alignment with the Educational Master Plan (EMP), monitoring how other planning activities align with EMP strategic directions and update the EMP, as needed.
- 4. Encourage and foster broad participation in college governance by modeling the way by regularly attending meetings, being prepared for meeting, and communicate the activities and actions of this committee to our constituent groups.

CEMPC began reviewing the APUs for alignment with MC Educational Master Plan as specified in the CEMPC bylaws:

- Annually participates in the recommendation of institutional priorities based on College Educational Master Plan and District Strategic Educational Goals.
- Provides leadership for the annual review and update of the College Educational Master Plan.

With the leadership of the college researcher, Samantha Kessler, CEMPC developed a rubric for APU Review. Each CEMPC member is currently reviewing one APU.
