A company came in today to do an assessment of the damage due to the storm. It was mentioned that a request was made to the District to house a substation in building S above ground with a transformer for each building. It was mentioned that there is damage buildings P, Q and R. the estimate for the damages should be received sometime this week. It was mentioned that the solar panels are not used currently in case of an emergency. The drinking fountains are being turned on and the filters are being changed. HVAC-Initial test turned out well. Additional testing will be performed mostly like when we are up and running. The first phase of moving out the temporary trailers will start soon. The construction to the horticulture building, CDC, and the build out of Building S should start early spring of next year. It was asked if there were any questions or concerns for the build out of building S. It was asked if a presentation was given on the build out. Yes, a presentation and walk through was given. It was requested that Local 39 and I.T. should have a look at the information. It was noted that the project is not final at this time it has not passed the governing bodies. The plans were shared on screen. It was mentioned that the S Building space is being designed and built not from our own money.
