It was noted that she had announced in Spring 2016 her intention of no longer serving as CIC Chair, but since no one else on the committee would serve as chair, she agreed to extend her service at least another semester. A faculty retirement and several staffing issues in the Biology Department during the Fall semester led to her decision to return to the classroom full time in Spring 2017 semester, making it impossible to continue her duties on CIC.</p> <p>Arja and Clifton Coleman presented a proposal for a reorganization of CIC that would distribute the workload more fairly among members of the committee, provide support in the form of reassign time, remove the assessment duties from the Curriculum Specialist job description, and hire part time staff to assist in the clerical aspects of curriculum work.
