CCCCO Memo ES 20-12 Emergency Temporary Distance Education Blanket Addendum for Summer or Fall 2020 Thai provided summary of Memo ES 20-12: The California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office (CCCCO) issued Memo ES 20-12 on March 31, advising colleges to plan proactively for instructional contingencies for the fall 2020 semester in light of the COVID-19 crisis. Although Merritt currently has an approved emergency temporary distance education blanket addendum to deliver all courses online until June 30, additional addenda need to be requested by May 20 for summer 2020 and by July 1 for fall 2020. Each request must include a plan for local approval of all courses included in the addendum by December 30, 2020.	
 The Curriculum Committee will develop a local emergency approval process for DE within the following parameters: All courses without approved DE addenda scheduled for the fall semester must be submitted for DE approval. DE approval for these courses shall be temporary and applicable only in emergency circumstances that preclude face-to-face instruction. DE approval is contingent upon adherence to the California Code of Regulations, title 5, sections 55204 and 55206, which require a DE addendum to the course outline of record specifying: How course outcomes will be achieved Regular and effective contact between instructor and student, and among students, either synchronously or asynchronously Compliance with the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act and Rehabilitation Act of 1973 CCCCO will conduct a webinar entitled Navigating Distance Education to provide information regarding the Emergency Temporary DE Blanket Addendum on April 13.
