Fitch, Thai and VPI Richardson attended a CurriQunet presentation on the catalog module and have several concerns: CurriQunet is very buggy and we don't have confidence that it would actually publish the catalog accurately; CurriQunet was developed as a curriculum management tool, not a publishing tool, consequently it is very limited in the way it presents information; format is very text heavy, not attractive nor engaging; requires curriculum inventory to be accurate; online catalog as presented is not the kind of branding that Merritt wants to convey to the public and our community. It is our opinion that Merritt is better off developing and producing our own catalog, until CurriQunet improves the catalog module.VC Brown plans to present at Tuesday's Board of Trustees meeting the catalog module contract amendment; cost to the district for the will be \$75,000.
