Remote Authentication

Merritt students, faculty, and staff can access library databases and e-books off campus via the library website by logging in with their Peralta student/employee ID numbers when prompted.

Technology

The Library provides 24 computers, a networked printer, and two photocopiers for student use. Students may log into the library computers with their student ID numbers for two 2-hour sessions per day. Wireless Internet access is available throughout the library on an open Wi-Fi network called "peraltanet". Printing requires the purchase of a GoPrint card. Printouts and copies cost \$0.10 per page.

Instruction

LIS 85: Intro to Information Resources, an online credit course on information literacy, is presently offered. Consult the current class schedule for further details. Library research orientation sessions are also available for classes upon faculty request.

Reference

Librarians are available at the Reference Desk during all open hours to answer reference questions, demonstrate proper citation methods and styles, and assist students with their research.

Study Space

Individual carrels with electrical outlets, as well as communal tables, are situated throughout the Library for student use. Groups of two or more may reserve one of the three study rooms for a two-hour period with a student ID card.
