Role and Responsibilities of an Early Childhood Education Specialist :

- Facilitate and engage youth, teachers, and/or visitors in a variety of STEM educational programs and experiences. Be the lead educator for our early childhood programs and co-teach other programs within the educational portfolio. Note: In-person programs are conducted outdoors at CuriOdyssey adhering to current health and safety guidelines. Programs and classes will adapt as health and safety guidelines change.
- **Direct a facet of Camp CuriOdyssey.** Responsible for the preparation, implementation and evaluation of Growing Scientist PreK summer STEM camp.
- Contribute to the development of STEM content and activities that are rich, authentic, and learner-driven.
 Research and develop STEM curriculum specifically for CuriOdyssey's early childhood programs and add to the collective content library.
