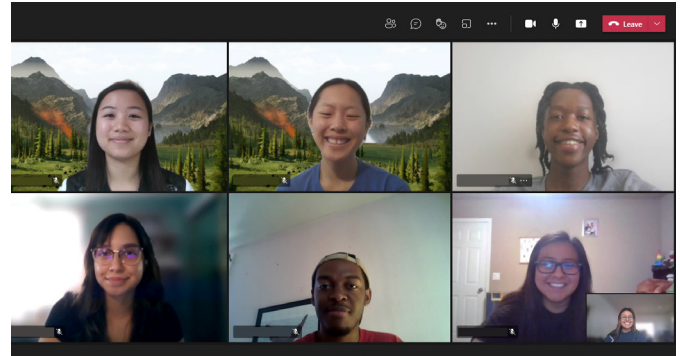




We Want You to Grow as Part of ESA's Team!
