- 1. With the growing number of cyber attacks in the world and the threat continuously evolving, there is a high demand in the field of cybersecurity.
- 2. Cybersecurity is one of the fastest-growing careers in the country, with more than 200,000 high-paying job openings in the U.S., a majority in the San Francisco Bay Area.
- 3. In just two years you can earn an Associate of Science Degree in Applications and Infrastructure Security Program in software (Applications) or hardware (Infrastructure).
- 4. This is one of the only community college programs of its kind in northern California. It is open to students at all levels of experience. There are no pre-requisites.
- 5. All classes are offered only on Fridays for the convenience of working students.
- 6. Internships are available with Bay Area companies to gain hands-on experience in the field, as well as assistance with obtaining a full-time job after graduation.
- 7. The courses are designed and team-taught by security industry experts currently working in the field in Silicon Valley and the immediate Bay Area.
- 8. The program includes real-life, hands on situations to develop your technical security skills, such as helping companies with security breaches and developing security strategies.
