

STEPS TO APPLY & ENROLL AT MERRITT COLLEGE

1 Step 1: Apply for Admission New Student



For a first-time college student, please create an account at [Open CCC Apply](#)

***Make sure you choose Merritt College as your campus**

Check your email within 24/48 hours to get your Student ID Number and Password to log into your Student Campus Solutions account.

If you do not receive the email within 24/48 hours send an email to admissions@peralta.edu and include your application confirmation number.

1 Step 1: Apply for Admission Returning Students

Returning students are those who have missed 2 consecutive main semesters, for example Spring & Fall; they must also submit an application through OpenCCApply.)

Go to Step 4 to talk to a counselor if you need to change your major, degree level, or you need to make any other changes to your educational plan, or go directly to Step 5.
