I. <u>ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS</u>

In accordance with your school's Associated Student's Constitution and Peralta District Policies and Procedures ALL candidates shall meet the following requirements:

- A. Be enrolled and registered during the spring semester elections are being conducted at the Institution you are applying for office.
- B. Must be registered a minimum of five (5) units at the Institution you are applying to run for elections during spring semester of elections.
- C. Show evidence of minimal cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0.
- D. Write-in candidates must meet eligibility requirements stated above and must receive a minimum of twenty- five (25) votes. (***Note the first (25) votes qualify you as a candidate, although they do not count toward your total votes).
- E. No student may be a candidate for or hold more than ONE (1) elected office simultaneously.
- F. Obtain the minimum FIFTY (50) current semester and registered students signatures at the Institution you are applying to run for elections. <u>Important: Students seeking a Student</u> <u>Trustee position, must obtain 200 votes-100 from your main campus, and 100 may be from any other</u> <u>PCCD campus.</u>
- II. Campaigning may begin the day of approval. No candidate may purchase campaign space. No campaigning within 50 feet of the polling place.
