How Do I Apply to CSU East Bay’s ADN to BSN program?

The ADN to BSN Advanced Placement Option is a 12 month intensive program. All courses are on-line except for the Community Health practicum and the Health assessment course. The program begins in the fall term after completion of the ADN program and passing the RN licensing exam (NCLEX). Incoming ADN students will be awarded 20 upper division college credit units for passing the NCLEX-RN exam.

Eligibility: 1) Enrollment in an ADN program & 2) Meet all CSUEB admission requirements
