2019 Seven Generations Scholarship – (Full-Time | Part-Time Students)

The Seven Generations Scholarship Fund Committee is proud to announce the third year of the Seven Generations Scholarship! The scholarship is open to full-time and part-time students. In addition, students will be eligible for a reimbursement for testing fees and/or test preparation courses.

****This year students who were recipients of the 2018 Seven Generations Scholarship will be qualified to apply to the Seven Generations 2019 Summer Internship Program starting June 11, 2019. If qualified, please see the attached form to apply to the 2019 Seven Generations Summer Internship Program.**

Scholarship Overview

The Seven Generations Scholarship Fund commits to empower our communities by investing in the education of future generations to provide financial assistance and pathways for Native American/Alaska Native students and Native American Health Center staff who reside in Alameda, San Francisco, and Contra Costa counties. The Seven Generations Scholarship is an investment in the health and education of our community and future generations.

PLEASE NOTE: All applicants will be contacted by letter by July 10, 2019 regarding award status. The scholarship will be paid on a reimbursement basis and will be awarded at the completion of the Spring 2019. Students awarded scholarship funds can only use funds towards their college tuition, room/board, fees, books, and transportation. ***If selected, recipients will be required to provide proof of how funds were spent, photograph, and personal biography for the scholarship's website. All scholarship recipients will also be required to provide an update of their academic status by October 4, 2019.***

Eligibility Requirements

- Must be tribally enrolled/affiliated (Federal, State or Tribal recognition)
- Reside in Alameda, Contra Costa, or San Francisco counties of the State of CA
- High school graduate or equivalent
- Accepted to or currently attending a non-profit and accredited community college, university or vocational/technical training institution located in the U.S.
- GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Must be enrolled as a full-time or part-time student (at least one class that is three (3) semester units or four (4) quarter units)

Required Documents

- Completed Application
- Official Spring 2019 Transcript (showing GPA of 2.5 or higher)
- Class Schedule showing full-time or part-time status
- Personal statement
- Letter of recommendation from instructor/advisor/ counselor

Selection Criteria

The Seven Generations Scholarship committee will review each completed application and will make awards based upon specific criteria and information provided in the application. Selection criteria includes:

- Completed Application (***incomplete or late applications will not be reviewed***)
- Current GPA
- Personal Statement
- Letter of recommendation from instructor/ advisor/ counselor

Important Dates

- Application Opens: March 6, 2019
- **Application Closes: Tuesday, April 30, 2019 at midnight.**
- Acceptance Notification: Wednesday, July 10, 2018
- Award Dinner: Thursday, July 25, 2019
- **Academic Status and Expense update due: Friday, October 4, 2019**

Scholarship Awards:

The following awards will be given contingent on selection criteria and available funding.

Full-time awards amounts:

- \$1000 Technical or Vocational School
- \$1500 Community College
- \$2000 Undergraduate (four year degree)
- \$2500 Graduate degree or higher

Part-time awards amounts

(Class must be at least 3 semester units or 4 quarter units):

- \$200/class: Technical or Vocational School
- \$300/class: Community College
- \$400/class: Undergraduate (four year degree)
- \$500/class: Graduate degree or higher

Additionally, students can apply for a reimbursement up to \$500 for SAT, ACT, GRE, LSAT, MCAT, GMAT test fees and/or test preparation courses. Documentation of payment for test fee and/or test preparation course is required. The course must have been taken after March 1, 2018.
